- part of your cultural community



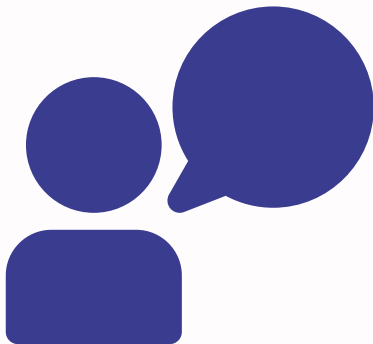
You should be able to:

- express your sexuality
- communicate in your family's language



You should be able to:

- make complaints
- say you want to go another provider

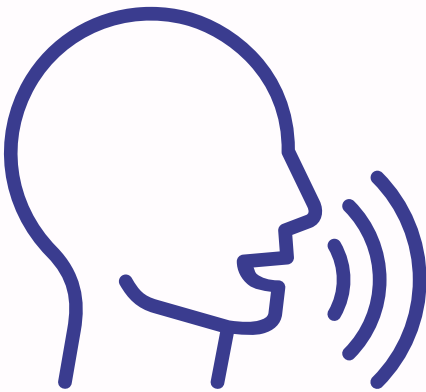


You can tell us what you want and when you want it.



You can tell us what type of worker you want.

You can tell us how you want things done.



You can ask another **trusted person** to communicate with us.

This might be a family member, carer, friend or other person.

The trusted person can speak for you.



We will always follow your instructions, unless we feel that you may get hurt. Then we will talk to you or your trusted person about the risk.



We agree to follow your wishes and Charter of Rights.
